Ludwig van Beethoven (1770 – 1827)

Ludwig van Beethoven führte die Wiener Klassik zu ihrer höchsten Entwicklung und bereitete der Musik der Romantik den Weg.

In seinen jungen Jahren entwickelte sich *Beethoven* zu einem bekannten Klaviervirtuosen, der das freie Improvisieren und Fantasieren auf dem Piano beherrschte. In Wien führte ihn sein Talent bald in die höchsten gesellschaftlichen Kreise der habsburgischen Hauptstadt. Seine Schwerhörigkeit, beendete seine Karriere als Pianist vorzeitig und *Beethoven* konzentrierte sich mehr und mehr aufs Komponieren. *Beethovens* letzte Jahre waren von zahlreichen Krankheiten geprägt.

Aus seinem umfangreichen konzertanten Werk stechen insbesondere seine neun Sinfonien hervor. Daneben schuf er u. a. fünf Klavierkonzerte, ein Violinkonzert, mehrere Ouvertüren, die Oper *Fidelio*, die *Missa solemnis* sowie eine Vielzahl kammermusikalischer Werke.

Beethovens Popularität war schon zu Lebzeiten unbestreitbar und er gehört heute zu den meistgespielten Komponisten der Welt.

5.Sinfonie c-Moll Op.67 (1808)

Diese Sinfonie – auch unter „Schicksalssinfonie“ bekannt, ist eines der populärsten Stücke der klassischen Musik und beinahe jeder kennt das prägnante Anfangsmotiv des ersten Satzes. Diese Sinfonie wird im Sinne eines Schicksalsdramas als eine musikalisch objektivierte Erzählung von Niederlage und Triumph interpretiert, vom ewigen menschlichen Schicksalkampf, von Leid und Erlösung.

Der dritte Satz ist ein Scherzo und wird nicht als eigenständiger Satz angesehen, sondern als Überleitung zum Finale. Er endet auch nicht sondern mündet ohne Unterbrechung in den vierten Satz. Das immer wieder kehrende Bassmotiv über mehr als 2 Oktaven ist in den Tuben als ad lib. versehen, kann weggelassen werden und nur von den tiefen Holzbläsern gespielt werden. Ebenso die geläufigen quasi Trio-Stellen.



- C Posaune 1/2, C Posaune 3:** Enter sequentially, each playing a melodic line.
- C Euphonium 1/2:** Plays a melodic line with dynamic marking **tacet ad lib.**
- C Bass:** Enters with a sustained note followed by a melodic line with dynamic marking **pp**.
- Kontrabass:** Enters with a sustained note followed by a melodic line with dynamic marking **poco rit.** and **a tempo**.
- Pauken:** Enters with a sustained note followed by a melodic line.
